Rules for Entry

2. Contestant must have sponsor within the county.
3. Contestant must have escort for Crowning Ceremony.
4. Contestant must attend judging on July 18, 2017, and crowning event on July 20, 2017.
5. Queen contestant must be in age category of 14-19 years old (ages as of July 1, 2017).
6. Princess contestant must be in age category of 9-13 years old (ages as of July 1, 2017).
7. Little Miss contestant must be in age category of 5-8 years old (ages of July 1, 2017).
8. Contestant must submit two (2) photographs suitable for judges viewing by July 1, 2017.
9. No formal dresses, please.
10. Contestant should wear age-appropriate Sunday dress for both the interview and the Crowning Ceremony.
11. Winners will be required to pass out ribbons for fair events.

Rules for Sponsoring Candidate For County Fair Queen & Princess

1. Any McDonald County business, youth group, or organization may have one entry in the Princess, Queen Contest, and/or Little Miss.
2. The sponsor is responsible for flowers (corsage) for their candidate.

Rules for Selection of Winners

A panel of well-qualified judges will be given contestant's personal information, plus a personal interview on Tuesday, July 18, at 7:00 p.m. at the McDonald County High School. Contestants will be judged on poise, personality, grooming, and school/community activities.

1. There will be twelve (12) divisions (boys and girls).
0-4 months; 5-8 months; 9-12 months; 1 year olds; 2 year olds; 3 year olds
2. All contestants will register between 9:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on Saturday. Contest to begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Fair Building (un-airconditioned).
3. Registration fee will be \$5.00. Make checks payable to the "McDonald County Fair."
4. Dress will be comfortable, cool, casual play clothes.
5. Contestants will be judged on grooming, cleanliness, and personality.
6. All contestants will receive a gift. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each division. There will be a grand champion boy and girl chosen from the category winners. Participant ribbons will be awarded to everyone. First place trophies will be awarded in each division Rosette Ribbons will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd place in each division. Grand champion trophies will be awarded to one boy and one girl.

COMMERCIAL BOOTH AND CONCESSION STAND RULES

McDonald County Chamber of Commerce

1. All advance booth reservations must be accompanied with a deposit in the amount of \$30.00 for each space requested.
 - A. All advance deposits will be considered fair board money and will not be returned to depositor.
 - B. All groups/individuals must pay for booth space regardless of whether it is a money-making project or not.
2. Commercial concessions selling food items will be charged a flat fee of \$125.00.
3. Outside commercial booth exhibit space will be limited to: three automobiles, three pieces of farm machinery, or the equivalent: \$25.00. Exception—Extra space will be granted to these exhibits provided that space is available and does not interfere with other exhibitors.
4. Exhibitors requiring space for less than the allowed three days will be charged at the rate of \$10.00 per day.
5. Commercial booth chairpersons have the right to reject any and all exhibitors for violation of safety rules or conduct.
6. NO livestock will be stalled in commercial booth space building. Space will be provided outside the building, provided that the exhibitor brings their own pens, etc.

1. NO dog will be allowed on fair grounds without proof of current vaccinations.

5. Dogs need to be 6 months or older by July 1, 2017.
